Cleaning the Barrel – Removing adhesive and sanding help prepare the barrel for paint

- $\hfill\square$  Adhesive remover (such as Goo Gone brand)
- □ Sponge
- $\hfill\square$  Sandpaper or sanding block
- □ Razor scraper
- Plastic tarp

## Installing the Hardware

- □ Measuring tape
- Permanent market
- $\hfill$  Drill with hole saw attachment

## Painting the Barrel – Applying paint will prevent algae from growing inside the barrel.

- □ High Build Binding Primer (one gallon)
- □ Tint for paint (optional)
- 🗆 Paintbrush
